1.0 Preparation for First-Class Mail

The following standards apply to single-piece First-Class Mail:

- a. Each piece must have a delivery address but is not required to bear the marking "First-Class" or "First-Class Mail."
- b. There are no sorting requirements for single-piece First-Class Mail, but five or more letter-size pieces bearing metered postage and all pieces bearing permit imprints must be faced with the addresses in one direction and bundled.
 Bundling of letter-size pieces is not required if they fill a letter tray. Metered mail and permit imprint mail may not be bundled or trayed together.
