USPS Launches Three Regional Processing & Distribution Centers (RPDCs) on June 29, 2026

To support the Postal Service's nationwide network modernization plan, three Regional Processing and Distribution Centers (RPDCs) will be activated on June 29, 2026. These RPDCs will help modernize our network to improve the employee experience and enhance operational capabilities to support package growth, while continuing to provide reliable, affordable, secure, and universal mail delivery.

With these activations, USPS will have modernized 18 RPDCs, associated with 66 Local Processing Centers (LPCs) nationwide. There are no impacts to existing customer origin entry. All future FAST appointments and origin entry volume will be scheduled at the RPDCs listed below:
